The Wharton Canal Day Association is pleased to announce its 35th Annual Canal Day Craft and Music Festival to be held on Saturday, August 21, 2010 from 10 to 5 pm, located at Hugh Force Canal Park, 270 W. Central Ave., Wharton, NJ. Canal Day is an old time country festival that celebrates the Morris Canal and its contribution to the development of the towns along its banks. This free event is a favorite of locals and has attracted thousands of people from as far away as Texas, New England and New York to learn of local history through free Boat Rides or by paddling a Kayak along the Morris Canal. Hand picked crafters from around the region will be attending the event to display their beautiful offerings. Musical performances from 10 of New Jersey's best artists will feature Rock, Blues, Country, Classical as well as traditional and contemporary Irish Folk Music and children of all ages will be delighted by the Wallaby Tales Traveling Zoo. Canal Day Terms of Agreement:

1. THE CANAL DAY ASSOCIATION HAS THE EXCLUSIVE RIGHT OF SALE FOR HAMBURGERS, CHEESE BURGERS, HOT DOGS, AND CHILI DOGS.

2. All food venders have exclusive rights to sell the food products approved by the Canal Day Association for a fee of \$75.00.

3. Food and/or beverages are NOT to be sold by any vendor unless approved by the Canal Day Association.

4. Each vendor understands that the menu it plans to work with is subject to this approval. Menu selections & prices must be submitted with your payment.

5. A vendor is allowed to sell only the products listed on the application or otherwise pre-approved by the Canal Day Association. It is understood that the rented space is to be used by the applicant only, and only the products listed on the application will be sold.

6. All food vendors will be provided a 12' x 12' area and will be responsible for providing their own set-up equipment i.e. tent, tables, chairs. (Electric power may be available upon request)

7. Tent(s) must be weighted & tent covering used must meet the following specifications: standard four-corner nylon or vinyl weaves (i.e. E-Z Up or metal frametype). TARP STYLE TENT STRUCTURES WILL NOT BE PERMITTED.

7. Each vendor must be set up and fully operational 30 minutes prior to the start of the Festival.

8. No vendor is allowed to leave the festival before 5:00 p.m. unless arrangements have been made prior to the Festival.

9. Food venders are responsible for setting up and tearing down displays and completely clearing their space leaving it as they found it.

10. All application, agreements and checks must be received by June 15, 2010.

11. The Wharton Borough Health Department requires that all food vendors complete a temporary food license application. (Available on the Canal Day Website.)

12. The applicant agrees to release and hold harmless the Borough of Wharton, Canal Day Association and Committee, and all parties from any and all liability, for personal injury and/or property damage, theft and/or damage of merchandise arising out of operation of exhibitor and agree to the Terms of Agreement listed. Morris County Park System Rules and Regulations apply: All provisions of the New Jersey State Motor Vehicle Act and Traffic Laws shall apply in the park and shall be strictly enforced. Application deadline is June 15, 2010. Festival is rain or shine. Application fee is not refundable.
